Wildlife First Responders Course 2025

What: Learn to be a Wildlife First Responder

When: Course access begins Saturday, February 1, 2025

Where: Online via Google Classroom

Who: Adults - Participants must be 18 years or older

Fee: \$40 (all proceeds benefit wildlife in care at TWC)

Our 2025 Wildlife First Responders course will be an online class with video segments, electronic handouts, live Q & A sessions via Google Meet, and an in-person reception at the center. The online course will be available February 1st-28th with optional in-person wildlife capture practice sessions.

You will learn when to intervene in wildlife situations and when not to, as well as how to capture, stabilize, and transport injured birds and other wildlife. While the main focus of the class is learning how to respond when you find wildlife in need, you will also be introduced to opportunities to help wildlife by volunteering with the center.

Those wishing to volunteer by answering our wildlife phone helpline for a 4 hour shift each week will receive a rebate of \$20 once started as a volunteer (with mentoring) after the course.
